- They are looking to collect feedback, comments and concerns prior to the AGM. (This item has been included as a discussion item in the agenda)

Officials

HLETICS MANITOBA

- A group of out-of-town officials were brought in to assist with the Canada West Championships.
 - o Bisons Sports and Athletics MB split the cost of their travel.
 - One of the AB officials was completing an evaluation, and we were also able to schedule an evaluation for of our MB officials
 - Overall, it was a very positive experience for all involved and a great opportunity for our local officials to work with some new people. (Especially after the last two years of very little action!!)
- A spring recruitment and training session needs to be organized!
- We must also schedule our Master Evaluator training, so that we can move forward with more local evaluations!
- FQA has developed a new Officials Database
 - o This has been a much-needed tool that all branches have struggled with over the years.
 - o It has been designed specifically to meet the needs of our community and allows branches to track and manage official's credits, levels, evaluations, and mentorships.
 - o There is an initial "buy-in" cost. The more branches that participate, the lower the cost will be. At the moment MB could anticipate approximately a 1k-2k initial investment.
 - o In addition to this one time "start up" cost, there would be an annual fee per active official, per year. Based on the current proposed business plan as presented by FQA, and our current officiating numbers, MB could anticipate an annual cost between \$1000-2000 to use the system.
- I am looking for Board approval to add this expense to our 2022-2023 budget. (This item has been included as a discussion/decision item in the agenda)

Staffing

- I would like to request an additional staff raise, for 2022-2023 fiscal year. Apologies, as this should likely have been included in last meetings salary update/requests.
- Shirley has been working for Athletics Manitoba since 2004 (minus a short one-year sabbatical in 2017) and has only had 2 increases, with the last one in April 2016.
- She is currently earning \$20 an hour. She handles the majority of our financial transactions and has worked hard and diligently to get and keep the books up to date. She manages the membership database, a portion of the website and helps with track meet management as needed. She is the most experienced user of Hy-Tek, our meet management software, and holds a substantial amount of general sport operational background/history. All members of our office staff (in addition to other members of our Athletics community at large) rely on her knowledge and expertise on a regular basis. She continues to be flexible with her hours, which is a huge asset to AM.
- I hope you will consider my request for an increase and would like to propose a \$3.50-\$5.00 an hour increase. \$3.50 is around a 2.5% increase per year over the last 6 years. (This item has been included as a discussion/decision item in the agenda)
- Summer Students job posting closes on Friday April 8th.
 - o Applications will be reviewed on Monday, and interviews will be scheduled immediately.

- Preliminary work was done based on the AC templates, and then a secondary review was completed as a group and unique local/Sport MB elements were included/updated where necessary.

 - o Athlete protection guidelines
 - o Safe sport
 - o Dispute resolution
 - o Appeals
 - o Risk Management
