Coach Schexnayder is one of the finest jumps coach's in the world, most recently guiding Walter Davis to the World Indoor and Outdoor Championship titles in Triple Jump.

Irving Schexnayder

Currently the head jumps coach at Louisiana State University, Coach Schexnayder also serves as the USA Track and Field Jumps Development Chair, and lectures for USATF at their level II and level III Coach Education Schools. Respected world wide he has been asked to present his methods to coaches in the UK and the NACAC regions.

Sprints and Hurdles



Coach Murray developed some of the best national team sprinters and hurdlers to represent Canada. His athletes (Robert Esmie, Tara Self (nee Perry), Tim Kroeker, Laurier Primeau, Tom Zverina, Yvonne Mensah, Philomena Mensah, and Peter Ogilvie) have competed at the Olympic Games, World Championships, Commonwealth Games, Francophone Games, World Junior Championships and Pan American Games. Adding to this highly accomplished resume, Coach Murray served as a National Team Coach for the only relay team in the world to defeat the Americans in the 4x100m.

Throws



Dr. Anatoly Bondarchuk is renowned as an athlete (1972 Olympic Champion and European Champion in the hammer throw as well as a former World Record Holder), and his coaching credentials are virtually unprecedented in the sport of Athletics.

From 1976 to 1992, athletes under Dr. Bondarchuk's direction captured Gold, Silver, and Bronze in

the hammer throw at four different Olympic competitions. In total, his athletes have captured 23 Olympic medals. His hammer throwers alone own five World Championship titles. Dr. Bondarchuk will be sharing his technical understanding for the throws events as well as his approach to planning for success in competition.

Distance



Coach Gmitroski is arguably one of the most successful distance coaches in the world. Under his direction athletes such as Gary Reed, Diane Cummins, Aimee Teteris, Graham Hood, Angela Chalmers, Zach Whitmarsh, Robyn Meagher and Bruce Deacon have made the step into the elite ranks as semi-finalists and finalists at the world level. Among their achievements are 6 Canadian records and 3 top ten all-time world best performances.
