IN ALL AGE CATEGORIES - 60M, 60MH AND 200M, MAY PROCEED FROM HEATS TO FINALS. ALL OTHER TRACK EVENTS WILL BE RUN AS TIMED SECTION FINALS.

ALL FIELD EVENTS WILL BE RUN AS FINALS. (IN THE LJ, TJ, SP - ALL GET THREE ATTEMPTS - TOP EIGHT GET THREE MORE) (EVENTS WITH MORE THAN 20 COMPETITORS MAY GET ONLY THREE ATTEMPTS)

IMPORTANT - Seed times will be used to make up event heats for events to go from heats to finals and to place all the best performers in fast heats in timed final events. It is important to provide seed times if available so your athletes will be placed in the proper heat according to their ability.
