2008-2009 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL INFORMATION

Please note that a school membership is valid September through June.

School Club Registration

For Elementary School Programs, there is a \$50 membership fee with Athletics Manitoba if the school only participates in one sanctioned event or a \$100 membership fee to compete in all sanctioned events. Schools must have a membership with Athletics Manitoba in order to register for an event. **All registration forms and fees must be submitted in order for a school to be eligible to compete.**

Athletics Manitoba uses Hy-Tek and Direct Athletics, an online registration system for all sanctioned events (other than Elementary relays, Track Attack and Hershey's Track and Field Games). Training for Hy-Tek or Direct Athletics registration can be done for free at the Athletics Manitoba office during business hours, or special arrangements can be made for evenings and weekends. Athletics Manitoba computers may be used or schools can bring their own. Group sessions are available. All school will be required to submit their athlete rosters by Hy-Tek. If a school does not submit by Hy-Tek they can enter their athlete roster via EXCEL (contact the office for form) and pay a surcharge of \$75.00 to have Athletics Manitoba enter their rosters. **NO PAPER REGISTRATIONS OF ROSTERS WILL BE ACCEPTED**. Contact Athletics Manitoba for details on entering athletes on EXCEL.

If Schools have a road running program, but not a track & field program, there is a \$25.00 School Run Manitoba membership that will enable students to receive the Run Manitoba discount at Athletics Manitoba sanctioned road races during the school year (September-June) when registered and competing for/with their school. Schools with full school memberships are also eligible to register for road running events.

Other Programs

Hershey's Track and Field Program: The Hershey's Track and Field program is for students ages 9-14 (age as of December 31, 2009). Schools can register existing school and divisional meets or organize a new meet as Hershey's Track and Field Qualifying meets. Students who finish first through third, plus all those who meet provincial standard will be invited to the Manitoba Hershey's Track and Field Championships in June with athletes having the opportunity to advance to the North American Championships in Hershey, Pennsylvania (all expenses paid) in August. Schools may request a FREE Hershey Program Manual with information on hosting a Hershey Qualifying Meet for your school. If your school hosts a meet, Athletics Manitoba can also provide participant certificates, prizes and some organizational support.

<u>School Workshops</u>: Member schools can request free half-day school clinics or workshops on specific track & field training topics. Contact the office for information and availability.

<u>Coaching Resources</u>: Coaches have access to the Athletics Manitoba Library as well as a network of coaching contacts and coaching clinic opportunities.

Run Jump Throw: Run, Jump, Throw is the nationally recognized grassroots track and field program in Canada. Full and half day workshops can be arranged as can full 10 direct delivery classes. Schools can also get full NCCP certification in the Run, Jump, Throw program and use the scripted lesson plans in their own physical education classes.
