For a MTFOA official to have his/her name submitted to a requesting Host Organizing Committee's Officials Coordinator, the following criteria must be met:

- Paid current yearly membership fee
- Have worked 40% indoors
- Has worked 40% outdoors

Our Branch Officials Chair submits all names of officials (name, level and discipline) who meet the criteria. The Host Organizing Committee's and their Officials' Coordinator will decide who they want from our list. The Officials' Coordinator can now contact you directly and MTFOA is no longer involved in the process.

All requests for out of province officials must go through our BOC and follow NOC policy on requesting officials.
