Other Programs

Hershey's Track and Field Program: The Hershey's Track and Field program is for students ages 9-14 (age as of December 31, 2010). Schools can register existing school and divisional meets or organize a new meet as Hershey's Track and Field Qualifying meets. Students who finish first through third, plus all those who meet provincial standard will be invited to the Manitoba Hershey's Track and Field Championships in June with athletes having the opportunity to advance to the North American Championships in Hershey, Pennsylvania (all expenses paid) in August. Schools may request a FREE Hershey Program Manual with information on hosting a Hershey Qualifying Meet for your school. If your school hosts a meet, Athletics Manitoba can also provide prizes and some organizational support.

School Workshops: Member schools can request free half-day school clinics or workshops on specific track & field training topics. Contact the office for information and availability.

Coaching Resources: Coaches have access to the Athletics Manitoba Library as well as a network of coaching contacts and coaching clinic opportunities.

Run Jump Throw: Run, Jump, Throw is the nationally recognized grassroots track and field program in Canada. Full and half day workshops can be arranged as can full 10 direct delivery classes. Schools can also get full NCCP certification in the Run, Jump, Throw program and use the scripted lesson plans in their own physical education classes. Registration as a School will involve a yearly fee for each school based on the number of students members (valid September through June). Students do not need to register as individual members of the association, unless they want to be involved in additional Athletics Manitoba programs. The registration fees will cover **all athletes and coaches**, and additional members can be added at any time during the year at **no additional cost** provided that all are registered students of the same school.

- 25 or more members \$175.00
- 24 or less members \$105.00

Athletics Manitoba uses Hy-Tek and Direct Athletics, an online registration system. Training for Hy-Tek or Direct Athletics registration can be done for free at the Athletics Manitoba office during business hours, or special arrangements can be made for evenings and weekends. Athletics Manitoba computers may be used, or schools can bring their own. Group sessions are available. If Schools have a road running program, but not a track & field program, there is a \$25.00 School Run Manitoba membership that will enable students to receive the Run Manitoba discount at Athletics Manitoba sanctioned road races during the school year (September-December) when registered and competing for/with their school.

All competition results will be posted on the Athletics Manitoba website. Any school that has students with privacy issues must submit the year of birth, gender, and two word code for the athlete, made up of letters only, with each word containing a minimum of one letter for Hy-Tek registration and meet results.

- Your school does not have access to bingo fund-raising program
- Your student athletes do not have access to funded programs (Canada Games, Western Canada Games, etc.)
