Staff coaches must be minimum NCCP Competition Development <u>fully certified</u>. Those coaches accredited through the old NCCP Level 3 system must demonstrate professional development activities within the past 5 year's time period. All coaches must also commit to becoming a Charter or Associate member of Coaches of Canada (<u>www.coachesofcanada.com</u>) before the commencement of the 2013 Games competition. Staff coaches must commit to being actively involved in building the sport of track and field in Manitoba; particularly within his/her event area through activities as active coaching, coaching clinics, talent identification and development.
