

MB GAMES - SELECTION CRITERIA WINNIPEG

The Winnipeg Region MB Games Teams (Blue and Gold) will be selected based on results achieved at the qualifier meet on June 21st & 22nd in Selkirk at the Selkirk Community Stadium (221 Mercy St., Selkirk, Manitoba R1A 2C8). Please note, these trials are being hosted as part of the Athletics Manitoba Outdoor Age Class Championships.

Final Team Selection will occur after the completion of the event with all members being contacted by June 24th-25th

Athletes will not be able to participate in more than 5 events. The team will be selected based on the following points system. Those athletes with the highest point total after all their events have been added up will be selected to the team first and so forth.

 1^{st} place in an event = 8 points 2^{nd} place in an event = 6 points 3^{rd} place = 5 points 4^{th} place = 4 points 5^{th} place = 3 points 6^{th} place = 1 points

Head coach for the Winnipeg Region Blue team is Shane Smith (<u>shaner49@shaw.ca</u>). The remaining staff members are being finalized and will be confirmed in the coming weeks.

If an athlete is *unable to compete* in Winnipeg Selection Trials, they must provide the Team Manager or Head Coach with a letter of appeal. An appeal letter should include the following contents:

- Athletes Name and Age Category (U14/U16).
- What event(s) are declaring for and the associated personal bests.
- Include results from previous meets from April 1st, 2024.
- A clear and valid explanation of why the athlete couldn't compete at the Winnipeg Selection Trials.

Please note: Appeals do not guarantee selection to the team; as well, athletes appealing in multiple events may not be selected for all events.

All athletes who would like to be considered for Team Winnipeg MUST declare interest at the link below no later than **June 20th, 2024.** If an athlete does not declare interest, they will NOT be considered in selection.
