Coaching Apprenticeship Opportunity

Coaching Apprenticeship Scholarship for 6 Sprint Hurdle Coaches

August 23rd-25th leading into the Canadian Athletics Coaching Conference August 25th -27th Edmonton, Alberta, at Foote Field.

Outline:

We aim to identify 6 developing coaches from across the country to take part in an applied apprenticeship opportunity here in Edmonton. These coaches will take part in a three day formal apprenticeship program aimed at developing their technical and planning skills. At the conclusion of the apprenticeship they will participate in the Coaching Conference to attain their level three technical. The selected coaches will have their airfare, accommodations, and meals paid for by the Canadian Athletics Coaching Centre. In addition we will cover the costs of the conference that follows. In essence we are providing an enriched level three technical program for six coaches.

Criteria:

- Coaches interested in this program must have the support of their provincial branch.
- Branches should identify coaches whom they feel will support their provincial program.
- Branches should identify coaches whom they feel have the potential and dedication to take the next step in coaching at the provincial and national level.
- Coaches must be level one certified or possess their level two technical to participate in this program.
- Coaches must possess a proven track record of involvement for at least three years in the sport at the local, regional and provincial arena.

Application Process

- I. Apply through email to the Canadian Athletics Coaching Centre tdickson@sports.ualberta.ca. Include a resume with the following points
 - a. Outline your past involvement in the sport.
 - b. Outline why you wish to participate in, and what you hope to gain through this opportunity.
 - c. A list of athlete accomplishments (include the age, event and performances of the athletes).
 - d. The names and numbers of 3 Coaching References from people that you have worked with, or for, over the past three years.
- 2. Forward a copy of your application information above to your provincial branch.
- 3. After the applications have been received and applicants have been short listed there will be a brief phone interview.

Approval Process

- 1. Coaches will be selected by region:
 - 2 Coaches from Western Canada (BC/Alberta/Yukon)
 - I Coach from the Prairie Provinces (Saskatchewan/Manitoba/NWT)
 - 2 Coaches from Central Canada (Ontario/Quebec/Nunavut)
 - I Coach from Eastern Canada (NB/PEI/NS/NF and Labrador)
- 2. Selection is heavily weighted upon the endorsement of the provincial branches within the region.

Coach applications must be received by August 4th
