

HIGH SCHOOL CLUB PROGRAM

Registration as a School Club will involve a yearly fee for each club based on the number of club members (valid September through June). Students do not need to register as individual members of the association, unless they want to be involved in additional Athletics Manitoba programs. The registration fees will cover **all athletes and coaches**, and additional members can be added at any time during the year at **no additional cost** provided that all are registered members of the same school.

- 25 or more members \$175.00
- 24 or less members \$105.00
- Additional Processing Fee \$75.00 for those submitting an EXCEL roster

Athletics Manitoba uses Hy-Tek and Direct Athletics, an online registration system. Training for Hy-Tek or Direct Athletics registration can be done for free at the Athletics Manitoba office during business hours, or special arrangements can be made for evenings and weekends. Athletics Manitoba computers may be used, or schools can bring their own. Group sessions are available. If a school chooses to register using EXCEL, (contact the office for the form), an additional processing fee of \$75.00 will be charged.

If Schools have a road running program, but not a track & field program, there is a \$25.00 School Run Manitoba membership that will enable students to receive the Run Manitoba discount at Athletics Manitoba sanctioned road races during the school year (September-December) when registered and competing for/with their school.

All competition results will be posted on the Athletics Manitoba website. Any school that has students with privacy issues must submit the year of birth, gender, and two word code for the athlete, made up of letters only, with each word containing a minimum of one letter for Hy-Tek registration and meet results.

A Provincial Outdoor Junior High School Championship is currently being discussed for those students from grade 7-9. Details will be posted on the Athletics Manitoba website once finalized.

- Only member schools of Athletics Manitoba are allowed to register at sanctioned meets.
- Insurance Coverage for the full year, including training
- Club contact information on the Athletics Manitoba web site
- Max Bell Exclusive Use access at a cost of \$5.00 per person per session on a pre-arranged basis
- Free Hy-Tek or Direct Athletics training (if required) for athlete and meet registration
- Reduced cost for Athletics Manitoba technical courses and other coaching clinics

Limitations (unless student athletes register as individual members with Athletics Manitoba)

- Your club does not have voting status at the Athletics Manitoba Annual General Meeting
- Your club does not have access to bingo fund-raising program
- Your student athletes do not have access to funded programs (Canada Games, Western Canada Games, etc.)
