## **2006 – 2007 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL INFORMATION**

Athletics Manitoba has developed a package for elementary schools. This package will enable the school to take part in all association meets, attend a special elementary relay event in the Max Bell Center, access to free resources to host a Hershey Qualifying meet (for 9-14 year olds,) have access to track and field clinics at a nominal fee and receive free \*training (if required) and support for using Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite to register your athletes with Athletics Manitoba.

This program is available to all Elementary schools in the Province of Manitoba. It has been designed specifically to address the needs and encourage the development of Elementary school track & field programs.

Registration in this program will involve an annual fee of \$100.00 for those schools who register using Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite (electronically) or \$175.00 for those schools who submit their registrations on paper. Athletics Manitoba will provide \*training and the Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite software free of charge for those schools wanting to submit their registration electronically. If you registered electronically last year, you need only add the names of the NEW athletes this year in Hy-Tek and delete those athletes no longer at your school. Please contact Athletics Manitoba for a backup copy of your roster.

If Schools have a road running program, but not a track & field program, there is a \$25.00 School Run Manitoba membership that will enable students to receive the Run Manitoba discount at Athletics Manitoba sanctioned road races during the school year (September-December,) when registered and competing for/with their school.

All competition results will be posted on the Athletics Manitoba website. Any school that has students with privacy issues must submit the year of birth, gender, and two word code for the athlete, made up of letters only, with each word containing a minimum of one letter for Hy-Tek registration and meet results.

Full Registration Includes:

- Schools will be able to register for all sanctioned meets including the Cargill and Boeing Indoor Games. Non-member schools are not allowed to compete in these and other sanctioned competitions.
- Schools will be entitled to compete at the Athletics Manitoba Elementary Relays at the Max Bell center for \$50.00 provided they supply at least 2 volunteers for the event or \$100.00 if no volunteers are provided
- A free Hershey Program Manual, along with support, prizes, certificates and resources to host a Hershey Qualifying Meet.
- Free software and training on Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite for electronic registration and management of athletes.
- Access to special school event and/or coach clinics at a special rate.
- Bulletins highlighting upcoming meets, clinics, etc. sent directly to the coach(es).

\*Training for Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite can be done for free at the Athletics Manitoba office during business hours, or special arrangements can be made for evenings and weekends. Athletics Manitoba computers may be used, or schools can bring their own. Group sessions are available. # 2006 – 2007 JUNIOR & SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLUB PROGRAM

Registration as a School Club will involve a once per year fee for each club based on the number of club members. Students do not need to register as individual members of the association, unless they want to be involved in additional Athletics Manitoba programs. The registration fees will cover **all athletes and coaches**, and additional members can be added at any time during the year at **no additional cost** provided that all are registered members of the same school.

- 25 or more members \$175.00 for Hy-Tek registration
- 24 or less members \$105.00 for Hy-Tek registration
- Processing Fee \$75.00 for those submitting a non-Hy-Tek roster

Athletics Manitoba will provide Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite software, information and \*training (if required) for free to schools that will register electronically. Athletics Manitoba will save the team file at this session and can collect the registration fees or can bill your school. If you registered electronically last year, you need only add the names of the NEW athletes this year in Hy-Tek and delete those athletes no longer at your school. Please contact Athletics Manitoba for a backup copy of your roster.

- Your student athletes do not have access to Provincial Teams
- Your student athletes are not eligible to compete at competitions outside Manitoba or at inter-provincial meets within the province
