Go For the Gold Funding (GFGF) SELECTION CRITERIA

General Information:

- 1. Athlete must be a member of Athletics Manitoba for 2004/05.
- 2. Athlete must be selected to Team Manitoba Athletics and compete in the 2005 Regina Canada Summer Games, August 13 20, 2005 to be eligible for GFGF funding.

Funding Information:

- 3. The funding is for team preparation and to assist Prep Squad athletes to participate in high level competitions leading up to the 2005 Regina Canada Summer Games.
- 4. Funding will be based on achieving A or B Standard.

 - Athletes achieving A standard will be eligible for a maximum of \$400.
 - Athletes attaining B standard will be eligible for a maximum of \$250.

- 6. Athletes eligible for GFGF funding may claim for appropriate expenses incurred up to commencement of the Canada Summer Games in Regina, August 6, 2005.

 - Transportation/accommodation/entry fees for ONE out-of-province competition OR
 - Entry fee for first event at Canadian Senior Track & Field Championships in Winnipeg
 OR

- 8. GFGF will be disbursed in September 2005 based on submitted receipts for eligible expenses **divided proportionately amongst total number of applicants for funding** to a maximum of \$400 for athletes attaining A standard and \$250 for athletes attaining B standard.
