



**NCCP FOR TRACK & FIELD COACHES – FROM “OLD” TO “NEW”**

Coaching education that is completed in the old NCCP between now and when Athletics Canada’s new programs are ready for implementation will be recognized. Coaches will not lose certification because they complete their education under the Old NCCP. Athletics Canada strongly encourages coaches to continue with their coaching education throughout the transition from the Old NCCP to the New NCCP program.

Once Athletics is fully operating in the New NCCP format (we estimate that this will be in 2010), current coaches will have 5 years to be evaluated and deemed competent (meet the certification requirements) in their specific context.

If you have completed NCCP training in Athletics and wish to continue your education, review the area that best describes you to determine your next steps.

If you are a:

**Trained or Certified Run, Jump, Throw Instructor and wish to gain more knowledge**

- Contact Athletics Manitoba to determine when the next Level 1 Technical Course will be offered.
- Contact Coaching Manitoba to determine when the next Introduction to Competition A course will be offered.

**Level 1 Certified and wish to gain more knowledge**

- Contact Athletics Manitoba to determine when the next Level 2 Technical Course in your event group area will be offered.
- Contact Coaching Manitoba and enroll in Introduction to Competition B (this course has replaced Level 2 Theory)
- Complete the practical coaching requirements for Level 2.

**Level 2 Certified and wish to gain more knowledge**

- Contact Athletics Manitoba to determine when the next Level 3 Technical Course in your event group area will be offered (you may be required to travel to another province as Level 3 in all event group areas are not offered on an annual basis).
- Contact your Coaching Manitoba and enroll in Level 3 Theory
- Complete the practical coaching requirements for Level 3.

**Level 3 Certified and wish to gain more knowledge**

- Contact the National Coaching Institute nearest you to inquire about enrolment in the National Coaching Institute Diploma Program or contact Donna Kaye at Athletics Canada.

**If you have completed sections of the old NCCP and wish to continue in the old NCCP, review the scenarios below to determine your next step. If you have:**

Completed Level 1 Theory, Level 1 Technical, but no Practical components:

Contact Athletics Manitoba regarding the requirements for completion of Level 1 Practical

Completed Level 1 Technical and Level 2 Technical, but no Theory and no Practical components:

Contact Coaching Manitoba and enroll in Introduction to Competition A and Introduction to Competition B.

Completed Level 1, 2, and 3 Technical, Level 1 Theory and no Practical components:

Contact your Coaching Manitoba and enroll in Introduction to Competition B, followed by Level 3 Theory.

Contact your Athletics Manitoba regarding the requirements for completion of the relevant practical components

If your specific scenario does not appear above contact Athletics Manitoba and/or Coaching Manitoba for assistance.

**I am a new coach working with children aged 7 to 12**
