## 2024 U16/U18 Provincial Team Programs STAFF APPLICATION

Application Deadline: June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Athletics Manitoba is seeking coaching staff applications for the following two U16/U18 Provincial Team Programs.

- 1) Western Canada Team Challenge July 19-21, 2024 (Winnipeg, MB)
- 2) Legion National Youth Track and Field Championships August 7-13, 2024 (Calgary, AB)

All interested coaches must be registered members of Athletics Manitoba with an active membership (Have completed the online Respect in Sport module and the screening requirements).

Eligible coaches must be Sport Coach or Club Coach trained and all members of either coaching staff must sign and abide by the Athletics Manitoba and Team Manitoba Code of Conduct.

If a coach does not have all of the necessary requirements at the time of their application, they may be granted permission to complete them prior to the events in question.

Coach/Chaperone responsibilities with either team will include,

- attending and supporting the team at the competition in question
- organizing team practices
- attending Trials and participating in the team selection meeting
- coordinating team entries
- communicating with athletes regarding travel arrangements

- Team Lead (1 Position)
- Team Manager (1 Position)
- Sprints/Hurdles/Relays (2 positions)
- Jumps (2 positions)
- Throws (2 positions)
- Distance (2 positions)

Legion National Youth Track and Field Championships Staff Positions (6 total)

- Team Coach (2 positions)
- Team Chaperone (4 positions)
  - Please note: The preference is to fill the Team chaperones positions with coaches as they ARE able to coach throughout the championship. Chaperones stay in the dorms with the athletes.
